**Revised Covid-19 guidance: please do not mingle before or after the service. We have received the following reminder from the Diocese: "Another critical area in the revised guidance is the importance of people resisting the urge to mingle before or after services. Due to the increased transmissibility of the new strain of Coronavirus and the fact that infections can occur when people are asymptomatic or pre-symptomatic, there is renewed emphasis on keeping at least two metres apart at all times – indoors or outdoors."**

Unfortunately due to the Covid restrictions the Volunteer Youth training that was due to take place on Sundays at 4pm is having to be cancelled again until restrictions are eased.

A Lent Course is starting on Wednesday afternoons at 2pm starting on Feb 24<sup>th</sup> at St Richard's Church.
